Installation Instructions



2021 to Current FORD F-150 FOF21PAK

*Tie Downs & Tailgate When Applicable Require Torx T30, T25, and T20 bits NOT INCLUDED

Please read all instructions before beginning the installation process. Install videos available at <u>DualLiner.com/dualliner-videos</u>

While temperature does not affect your DualLiner, it is easier to install when the bedliner is above 50 degrees Fahrenheit. If working in colder temperatures, it is helpful to warm the bedliner indoors prior to installation. The mat may take a "set" while rolled. If possible, unroll the mat and let it "relax" in the sun to make it easier to work with. If installing in cold weather it may take several weeks for the mat to fully relax.

IMPORTANT - Truck Bed Preparation:

• Use a T30 Bit to remove all four Factory Tie-Down Cleats and Four Box Link Plates (if applicable).

Step 1: Install the loadguard panel. (Fig. 1)

• Place over the front rail and snap in place. You may need to push as the loadguard is designed to fit tight.

Step 2: Install the sidewall panels. (Fig. 2)

- At Tailgate end, turn the rubber tailgate stopper out of the way.
- Starting at a 45 degree angle, slide the sidewall panel up and under the rail of the truck. Make sure that the panel does not get hung up behind the rail, it will tuck beneath the rail cap in the front, around the two pillars above the wheel well and beneath the rail cap at the rear near the tailgate. It may take a few tries to get it perfectly under the rail. Also, it is important to note that the holes may not look perfectly aligned at this stage—follow the install all the way to the end as the panels will shift until the ZeroSkid Rubber Floor[®] is in place.
- Repeat on the other side
- *Tip: If the top edge is not sitting flush with the rail cap, make sure it is not hung up on anything under the rail. Sometimes giving the panel a little pop with your fist will help push it into place. Keep in mind, at this stage the bolt holes may not look like they align. Once the mat is in, the panel will move and shift into proper position.

If your truck is equipped with LED lights and Pro Power Outlet, there are pre-cut holes for both lights and the switch and the power pack. If your truck is equipped with a bed extender, you will see three formed pin marks at the back edge of the side panel that aligns with the holes for your bed extender. Open these up to the correct size with a drill bit and reinstall your bed extender.

Step 3: Install the ZeroSkid Rubber Floor[®]. (Fig. 3)

- Lift the mat into the truck and unroll with nub side down.
- Start tucking the mat into the channel from front to back.
- * Tip: It is generally easiest to tuck one side, then the other side.
- Make sure it is pulled as far forward as possible for best fit.
- The mat will "settle" into position, sometimes giving it a kick or shuffling your feet will help it find its place.

Step 4: Reinstall factory hardware.

- Start reinstalling the factory tie-down cleats and box link plates (if applicable). The hole in the center of the box link plates should point up, like the Empire State Building.
- Finger tighten all fasteners first, then return to tighten.

*Note, you may have to lift the panel slightly to reinstall and align some of the holes, for the rear tie downs make sure the cleats are pointing out.

• Then turn the rubber tailgate stoppers back.

Step 5: Install the tailgate panel. (Fig. 4)

- Use a hand tool on the tailgate to avoid stripping the screws.
- With a T25 Bit remove all eight screws across the top half of the tailgate, you can set these aside, we have provided replacement hardware, which uses a T20 Bit.
- Start by aligning the tailgate panel holes to the holes in the truck. Place tailgate screws into shoulder washers and start reattaching the panel.
- Finger tighten, getting all screws started then go back and tighten with a hand tool.
- The tailgate panel will overlap the tailgate cap a bit; use the holes to find the proper alignment.

*Optional: Since the tailgate panel only attaches with hardware across the top half, we have provided double sided tape should you want to secure the bottom half.
